HORTICULTURE TENT — RULES & JUDGING

★ Get Planting! ★ Sunday 6th September 2026 • Bray Village Green • 11am onwards ★

We want everyone to have a brilliant time — here's everything you need to know!

★ THE RULES — KEEP IT FAIR, KEEP IT FUN! ★

- 1 All entries must be your own work**
Grown, made or created by you. For children's mini gardens, adults may help with safety — but the idea must be the child's!
- 2 One entry per person, per category**
You're very welcome to enter as many different categories as you like though!
- 3 Drop-off is between 10:30 and 11:30am**
We can't accept late entries once judging begins— please don't leave it too late!
- 4 Label everything clearly with your entry number**
You'll be given a number on arrival. Names stay hidden until judging is complete.
- 5 Judging takes place 11:00am–12:00pm — tent closed during this time**
No sneaking in for a peek! The tent reopens to the public at 12:15pm.
- 6 Judges' decisions are final**
- 7 Exhibits must remain on display until 4:00pm**
Please collect your entry after the prize giving ceremony at 3:30pm.
- 8 Perishable items cannot be returned after judging**
- 9 Children's entries must be made by children aged 14 or under**
- 10 The organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to exhibits**
Standard show rule—but we'll do our very best to look after everything!
- 11 Exhibits should be presented as naturally as possible**
No props or embellishments unless the category allows it (novelty veg and mini gardens are the exception!).
- 12 A Best in Show award may be given at the judge's discretion**

Each entry is scored out of 50 by our official judge across five criteria:

Condition
& Quality

/10

Presentation

/10

Uniformity
(if relevant)

/10

Flavour
(bakes & jams)

/10

Overall
Impression

★ TOTAL SCORE: out of 50 ★

People's Choice vote runs 12:15–3:00pm — everyone at the fete gets one vote!

The People's Choice winner receives their own special rosette alongside the official results.
